

Report to Memorial Centre Committee 2nd February 2021

Request from Fruit and Veg proprietor to operate an outside stall at the MMC

1. Please see attached letter at Appendix 2 requesting to site on a day to day basis a fruit and veg stall at the MMC on Tuesday from 6.30 am to 2.30 pm.
2. Local pop-up markets can operate in the Charnwood borough providing they have no more than five stalls. This would mean it falls below the minimum size definition of a market, and would therefore not be seen as a rival market un the charter which covers Loughborough Markets.
3. Only essential items may be sold during lockdown and all measures must be taken to ensure it is a Covid-secure environment. I have explained that he will need to ensure orderly queuing and social distancing.
4. If members decide to go ahead with this, after discussion with a member of the MMC staff, it is suggested that the arrangement is reviewed once the centre is open and fully operational again.
5. The applicant confirms he has public liability insurance and is registered with Blaby District Council
6. **Recommendation** Members views are sought.
