The yew trees in the Cemetery need reducing in height to a level where they can be maintained by our staff.

Report

Two quotations have been received and they appear to be different in scope the one from Tindle Tree Care is just doing what we have specified. The tender from Acorn is for more work than we have requested at this time.

I have discussed this with our Cemetery Gardener who was confident that Tindle Tree Care could undertake the work from their visit to assess the job. We have also used Tindle Tee Care in the past so they are a known contractor.

To commission Tindle Tree care to undertake the work on the yew trees for £860 + VAT

I've held off emailing you as I was waiting for someone to call me about Castle Hill... I've spoken to your Head Gardener and I have asked for someone to show me or give me a spec of what wants doing up there. Can you help with that at all, as I haven't heard anything? I noted multiple H&S issues at the cemetery which I also brought up on the site visit.

The quote for reducing approx 25 yew trees is £860 + Vat, to get them level and right there is a fair amount of work in it, more time consuming than physical graft.
